News and Views from Campaign for State Education – South East London

The Campaign for State Education (CASE) has been a grass-roots, non-party political organisation since the 1960s. We believe that a good education is the right of all citizens and that this is best achieved through a comprehensive education system. What have children, parents, teachers and governors done to deserve this?

Government's National Funding Formula proposal will mean less funding for London Schools, more for others.

London MPs' pleas to the Secretary of State for Education to ensure that all schools receive fair funding according to their needs, rather than cutting funding to London schools, seem to have fallen on deaf ears. The latest proposal from the Department of Education is that schools in major cities, including London, will receive up to 3% less funding per year, whilst schools in the counties and rural areas will receive up to 3% more. In the first two years, the cut in funding will be capped at 1.5% to assist schools to adjust. Under this proposal, 10,000 schools will gain (but by no more than 3%), 5000 schools will lose. Most schools in Lambeth, Southwark, Lewisham and Greenwich will lose funding under the proposal. The consultation closes on 22nd March 2017. The Government has indicated it wants to hear from parents and all other stakeholder.
